
Peer Review Procedure

1. Each article published in the journal “Academy of Management” is subject to the peer-review procedure.
2. Two reviewers from outside the academic institution with which the author of the publication is affiliated are appointed to assess each submission. If their assessments differ, the editor may appoint additional reviewers.
3. Reviews are conducted using a “double-blind review process”, which means that the author or authors and the reviewers are unaware of each other’s identities.
4. The review is submitted in writing and includes the reviewer’s clear recommendation as to whether the article should be accepted for publication or rejected.
5. The criteria for accepting or rejecting a publication and, where applicable, the review form are made publicly available on the journal’s website (Appendix 2).
6. The names of the reviewers of individual publications or issues of the journal are not disclosed.
7. In accordance with the guidelines of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education, the current list of reviewers cooperating with the journal will be published on the journal’s website.
